ORDINANCE NO. 2026-02

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY AND BOROUGH OF SITKA AMENDING TITLE 2
“ADMINISTRATION AND PERSONNEL” OF THE SITKA GENERAL CODE BY
AMENDING CHAPTER 2.31 “SUSTAINABILITY COMMISSION”**

1. CLASSIFICATION. This ordinance is of a permanent nature and is intended to become a part of the Sitka General Code (SGC).

2. SEVERABILITY. If any provision of this ordinance or any application to any person or circumstance is held invalid, the remainder of this ordinance and application to any person or circumstance shall not be affected.

3. PURPOSE. The purpose of this ordinance is to reduce the membership of the Sustainability Commission from seven to five members.

4. ENACTMENT. NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED by the Assembly of the City and Borough of Sitka that the Sitka General Code Title 2 entitled “Administration and Personnel”, Chapter 2.31, entitled “Sustainability Commission”, at Section 2.31.010 entitled “Sustainability commission” be amended to read as follows (deleted language stricken, new language underlined):

There shall be a commission known as the sustainability commission, which shall be composed of ~~seven~~ five members appointed by the assembly and, to the extent deemed advisable by the assembly and possible from the applicants, include at least one individual with background or training as a sustainability professional and at least one individual of Alaska Native heritage with understanding and appreciation of the historical importance of sustainability on Tlingit Aaní. All voting members of the commission shall be at-large members and representative of a diverse

cross-section of the community. The sustainability coordinator within the planning and community development department or designee shall be an ex officio member without a vote.

5. EFFECTIVE DATE. This ordinance shall become on the day after the date of its passage.
