**RESOLUTION NO. 2022-05**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY AND BOROUGH OF SITKA (CBS) AUTHORIZING THE MUNICIPAL ADMINISTRATOR TO APPLY FOR AND EXECUTE A GRANT WITH THE SOUTHEAST ALASKA FISH HABITAT PARTNERSHIP (SEAKFHP) FOR \$50,000 TO SUPPORT THE WACHUSETTS STORM SEWER REHABILITATION PROJECT**

**WHEREAS**, the CBS-owned culverts conveying Peterson Creek under Wachusett Street is badly corroded; and

**WHEREAS**, the culverts block or impede fish access to over half of the stream length of fish spawning and rearing habitat; and

**WHEREAS**, the SEAKFHP is soliciting applications for projects to protect, restore and conserve fish habitats in Southeast Alaska; and


**WHEREAS**, the proposed culvert is being designed to improve the fish-passage characteristics of the existing, failing Wachusett Street culvert.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Assembly of the City and Borough of Sitka to authorize the CBS Municipal Administrator to apply for and execute a grant with the SEAKFHP for \$50,000 to support the Wachusett Storm Sewer Rehabilitation Project with a required 1:1 match funded by the project's existing funding.
