I wish to be considered for an open seat on the Library Commission. I am a Sitka resident and have been a patron of the library since moving to Sitka 40 years ago. In fact one of my first jobs here in Sitka was shelving books under Tracy Allen, head librarian!

My resume includes a B.A. in Psychology/Urban Studies from Occidental College and an Elementary Education Endorsement plus 80 hours from the University of Alaska. I taught in the Sitka School District for 28 years, starting with 3<sup>rd</sup> grade in 1987 and then moving to Reading Recovery Intervention, and ending my career in 2<sup>nd</sup> grade. My Type A Teaching Certificate is still active and I have been subbing in the school district since my retirement from teaching 5 years ago. I have also assisted the Sitka Native Education Program over the last few years with curriculum development and program evaluations.

My earlier work history includes developing early childhood and adult education programs with a community college in Fort Steilacoom, Washington as well as working with the Puyallup Tribe in Tacoma, Washington setting up a tribal elementary school. My Sitka experience before teaching includes working in the tourism industry, setting up a parent lending library for preschool parents, Sitka Job Corps for teens, and grant writer and education director for Sitka Native Education Program under Isabella Brady.

I raised 4 children in Sitka and am currently retired here with my husband, Pete. He is retired from NSRAA and is currently the Chief Tribal Judge for Sitka Tribe of Alaska. We have no plans to relocate at this time.

My volunteer service includes: Ocean Wave Quilters, the Friends of Sheldon Jackson Museum, and the Iota Chapter of Delta Kappa Gamma. I have held various positions in all of these organizations.

As a Sitka Library user I have always been supportive of the many excellent and innovative programs the library has to offer. I am impressed with the quality and variety of the programs, and I am in awe of the library's ability to continue to service patrons safely during these Covid times.

I believe that a library is the cornerstone of a community and contributes to the community's health and wellbeing. Our library is a vital resource to the City and Borough of Sitka and its citizens. I would be honored to help the library fulfill its mission during these uncertain times and beyond!
