**A RESOLUTION BY THE CITY AND BOROUGH OF SITKA ASSEMBLY
SUPPORTING THE CITY AND BOROUGH OF SITKA FY'2012 CONGRESSIONAL
PRIORITIES**

WHEREAS, the City and Borough of Sitka, Alaska, has requested Federal assistance on four high priority projects for many years; and

WHEREAS, the Alaska Congressional Delegation has been very supportive of Sitka's highest priority requests, and in several instances has helped the City and Borough of Sitka receive partial funding for Sitka's highest priority projects; and

WHEREAS, this partnership between the Alaska Congressional Delegation and City and Borough of Sitka has been extremely beneficial in permitting projects such as upgrading the Municipal electrical system, infrastructure upgrades at Sawmill Cove Industrial Park, supporting the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers (COE) Sitka Harbor Breakwater Upgrade, and implementation of the Japonski Island Infrastructure Upgrade Plan;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Mayor and Assembly of the City and Borough of Sitka, as Sitka's elected officials, strongly support the following City and Borough of Sitka FY'2012 Congressional Priority Requests, as detailed in the enclosed Congressional request letter and the Delegation's Alaska Federal Appropriations Request Forms:

- SITKA BLUE LAKE HYDROELECTRIC EXPANSION PROJECT (Priority #1)
- SITKA SAWMILL COVE INDUSTRIAL PARK BULKHEAD (Priority #2)
- COE SITKA HARBOR BREAKWATER UPGRADE (Priority #3)
- SITKA JAPONSKI ISLAND INFRASTRUCTURE COMPLETION (Priority #4)

NOW, FURTHER BE IT RESOLVED that the Sitka Assembly appreciates the Alaska Congressional Delegation's assistance to Sitka to enable the City and Borough of Sitka and its State and Federal partners to complete these projects of great importance to the City and Borough of Sitka and its citizens.
