A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY AND BOROUGH OF SITKA, ALASKA AUTHORIZING MUNICIPAL MATCHING GRANT APPLICATIONS TO THE ALASKA DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENTAL CONSERVATION FOR HOLLYWOOD WAY WATER & SEWER/ NEW ARCHANGEL STREET SEWER IMPROVEMENTS, MONASTERY STREET & BARANOF STREET WATER & SEWER IMPROVEMENTS – SMC TO DEGROFF, AND JEFF DAVIS STREET WATER & SEWER IMPROVEMENTS

Whereas, the City and Borough of Sitka (CBS) seeks to obtain the necessary financial assistance to construct priority water and wastewater improvements; and

Whereas, the State of Alaska Department of Environmental Conservation has a Municipal Matching Grant program which could fund the water and sewer improvements; and

Whereas, the Municipal Matching Grant program will provide 70% of the funding and CBS would provide 30% of the funding for each project selected; and

Now therefore be it resolved by the Assembly of the City and Borough of Sitka that the Administrator is authorized to apply to the Alaska Department of Environmental Conservation for Municipal Matching Grants for planning, design and construction of the above referenced water and sewer projects and to execute the grant agreements if the projects are selected.
