10	WHEREAS, the City and Borough of Sitka recognizes the majority of the public boat harbors in
11 12	Alaska where constructed by the state during the 1960s and 1970s; and
13 14	WHEREAS, these harbor facilities represent critical transportation links and are the
15 16	transportation hubs for waterfront commerce and economic development in Alaskan coastal communities; and

18	WHEREAS, these harbor facilities are ports of refuge and protection for ocean-going vessels
19	and fishermen throughout the State of Alaska, especially in coastal Alaskan communities; and

21	WHEREAS, the State of Alaska during the past ten years has transferred ownership to local
22 23	municipalities of most of these state owned harbors, many of which were at or near the end of their service life at the time of transfer; and
