Hikes/Trails: Top 3 Trails to Hike in Sitka

1. Harbor Mountain Trail

- **Description:** A challenging yet rewarding trail with breathtaking views of Sitka Sound, the surrounding islands, and the snow-capped mountains. Ideal for experienced hikers.
- **Trailhead Location:** Harbor Mountain Road
- **Distance:** ~6.3 miles round trip
- **Difficulty:** Moderate to Difficult

2. Indian River Trail

- **Description:** A serene hike along a river through lush temperate rainforest, leading to a picturesque waterfall. Perfect for families and nature enthusiasts.
