A RESOLUTION OF THE ASSEMBLY OF THE CITY AND BOROUGH OF SITKA, ALASKA AUTHORIZING A GRANT APPLICATION TO THE ALASKA DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENTAL CONSERVATION FOR A STORMWATER MASTER PLAN, MANAGEMENT AND MAPPING PROGRAM.

- WHEREAS, the City and Borough of Sitka (CBS) seeks to obtain the necessary financial assistance to complete a stormwater master plan, management, and mapping program; and
- WHEREAS, the Alaska Department of Environmental Conservation (ADEC) is able to offer funding through the Alaska Clean Water Grants Fund; and
- WHEREAS, the Municipality wishes to apply for a grant from the Alaska Clean Water Grants Fund for the stormwater master plan, management, and mapping program; and
- **WHEREAS,** the Alaska Clean Water Grants Fund program requires a forty percent non-federal cost share/match.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Assembly of the City and Borough of Sitka, Alaska that the municipality is authorized to apply to the Alaska Department of Environmental Conservation for a grant from the Alaska Clean Water Grants Fund for the stormwater master plan, management, and mapping program.
