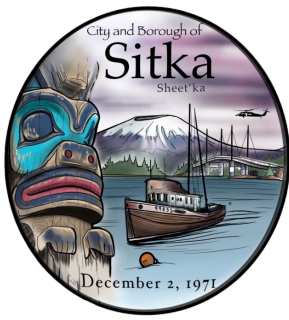

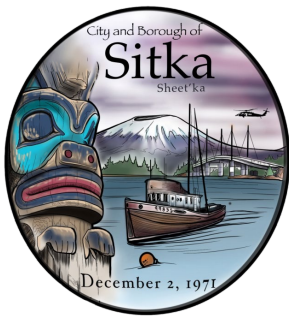
The Municipal Clerk's Office has received notification from the Alcohol and Marijuana Control Office of the liquor license renewal application listed below.
