SUPPORTING SITKA HISTORICAL SOCIETY'S APPLICATION UNDER THE FY18
HISTORIC PRESERVATION FUND GRANT PROGRAM FOR CERTIFIED LOCAL
GOVERNMENTS**

WHEREAS, the mission of the Sitka Historical Society is to preserve and promote the events, stories, and artifacts of the human history of Sitka, as part of the Pacific Northwest coast of North America, to inspire, educate, and benefit the public and future generations; and

WHEREAS, Sitka's bounty of cultural resources enriches the lives of Sitkans while also attracting heritage tourists to visit our community; and

WHEREAS, Sitka Historical Society's goal through this grant application is to conduct research and produce a publication documenting Sitka's diverse architectural history in order to advance public knowledge and heritage tourism; and


WHEREAS, Sitka History Museum proposes to contribute approximately \$4098 of in-kind and donated resources to the project while requesting approximately \$6147 from the Historic Preservation Fund for Certified Local Governments.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Assembly of the City and Borough of Sitka hereby supports the FY18 application of the Sitka Historical Society for an approximately \$6,147 grant through the Historic Preservation Fund Grant program for Certified Local Governments.
