

# Appointments: Tourism Task Force

## Step 1

Pursuant to Resolution 2023-11 the Task Force shall consist of nine representatives:

- Sheet'ká Kwáan Sitka Tribe of Alaska
- Port and Harbors Commission\*
- Sustainability Commission\*
- Downtown Business Corridor
- Business in General
- Tours and Attractions
- Sitka Sound Cruise Terminal
- Community At-Large (2 seats)

Commissions may appoint one of their own members or a member of the public. Members of the public appointed should be an advocate for interests and/or industries the Commission represents. The Port and Harbors Commission and the Sustainability Commission have chosen a member of the public to represent each commission.

## Step 2

**I MOVE TO** appoint:

- Camille Ferguson to the Sitka Tribe of Alaska seat,
- Scott Wagner to the Port and Harbors Commission seat,
- Barbara Bingham to the Sustainability Commission seat,
- Jeremy Plank to the Tours and Attractions seat, and
- Chris McGraw to the Sitka Sound Cruise Terminal seat.

Public comment to be taken after motion is made.

## Step 3

Nominations for “Business in General” seat:

**I NOMINATE** 1) Cambria Holmes, 2) Holly Reeder, and 3) Noah Rogers for the Business in General seat.\*

The Municipal clerk will ask each Assembly Member to state their applicant choice. To be appointed, an applicant must receive at least four votes.

## Step 4

Nominations for “Downtown Business Corridor” seat:

**I NOMINATE** 1) James Michener, and 2) Shirley E. Robards for the Downtown Business Corridor seat.\*

\*Public comment to be taken after nominations are made.

The Municipal clerk will ask each Assembly Member to state their applicant choice. To be appointed, an applicant must receive at least four votes.

## Step 5

Nominations for **two** “Community At-Large” seats:

**I NOMINATE** 1) Larry Edwards, 2) Phyllis Hackett, 3) William (Jerry) Jacobs, 4) Rich McClear, 5) Ronald Reda, and 6) Ral T. West for the two Community At-Large seats.\*

\*Public comment to be taken after nominations are made.
