A RESOLUTION BY THE CITY AND BOROUGH OF SITKA
SUBMITTING A MULTI PARCEL STATE LAND ACQUISITION REQUEST
TO THE STATE OF ALASKA

WHEREAS, the City and Borough of Sitka continuously pursues lands available for future community development including housing, community growth/expansion and/or economic development; and

WHEREAS, multiple State of Alaska land parcels have been identified as future growth areas including: State of Alaska parcel known as Indian River Valley, Department of Education parcel referred to as Millersville, State of Alaska parcel referred to as Starrigavan/Katlion Bay and Department of Education parcel located at the end of Seward Avenue; and

WHEREAS, these State of Alaska parcels appear to be unused or surplus to the State needs; and

WHEREAS, while State of Alaska budget shortfalls make community support through funding unlikely. Transferring state owned properties to the City and Borough of Sitka would provide additional housing opportunities for citizens and income generating opportunities for local government,

NOW FURTHER BE IT RESOLVED that the Assembly of the City and Borough of Sitka, Alaska, requests the State of Alaska to transfer ownership of the identified parcels to the City and Borough of Sitka for the purposes of community development. The City and Borough of Sitka continues to support cooperation between cities and State of Alaska to achieve our common goals.
