

**CITY AND BOROUGH OF SITKA
ORDINANCE NO. 2011-01**

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY AND BOROUGH OF SITKA ADDING SITKA
GENERAL CODE SECTION 2.60.005 ENTITLED “APPOINTMENT”
REGARDING QUALIFICATIONS OF BOARD, COMMISSION OR
COMMITTEE MEMBERS**

1. **CLASSIFICATION.** This Ordinance is of a permanent nature and is intended to become part of the Sitka General Code (“SGC”).

2. **SEVERABILITY.** If any provision of this Ordinance or any application to any person or circumstance is held invalid, the remainder of this ordinance and application to any person or circumstances shall not be affected.

3. **PURPOSE.** This Ordinance adds a provision requiring members of boards, commissions and committees to be qualified voters of the City and Borough of Sitka in order to be appointed by the Assembly and serve as members. This requirement shall apply to all those members appointed after the effective date of this Ordinance.

4. **ENACTMENT.** NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED by the Assembly of the City and Borough of Sitka that SGC 2.04.005 entitled “Appointment” is added to read as follows (new language underlined; deleted language stricken):

**Chapter 2.60
MUNICIPAL BOARDS, COMMISSIONS AND COMMITTEES**

Sections:

- 2.60.005 Appointment.
- 2.60.010 Quorum.
- 2.60.020 Affirmative vote on actions.
- 2.60.030 Recommendations—Endorsement.
- 2.60.040 Unexcused absences—Vacancies.
- 2.60.050 Teleconference participation.

2.60.005 Appointment.

When the Assembly appoints a member of a board, commission or committee to fill a vacancy, it shall only consider qualified voters of the City and Borough of Sitka. If a

44 board, commission or committee member no longer qualifies as a Sitka voter, a vacancy
45 shall occur.

49 5. **EFFECTIVE DATE.** This Ordinance shall become effective the day after
50 the date of its passage. It shall be applicable to all appointments or reappointments of
51 board, commission and committee members after the effective date. Regarding creation
52 of a vacancy when the member is no longer a Sitka voter, this only applies to those
53 appointed or reappointed after the effective date of this Ordinance.
