## **Background**

Sitka Voters passed Proposition No. 5 in the October 2010 Election approving the CBS use proceeds from the seasonal sales tax revenue to fund the 35% match required by the State of Alaska for the renovation of Pacific High School. The State of Alaska has provided 65% of the project budget funded through a grant. The Project Agreement between the State of Alaska and the CBS was signed in March 2011.

A contract with the Architectural Firm McCool Carson and Green (MCG) was awarded in June 2011. The Facilities Assessment began in July 2011 and the design process progressed through August 2012 when the project was offered for bids to construct the facility. The design process included multiple Building Design Committee Meetings, Public Meetings, Presentations to the Assembly, and Assembly approval of project milestones.

Bids were opened Tuesday, September 25, 2012.

#### Analysis

The Pacific High School Renewal Project was bid with a Lump Sum Base Bid item and six Lump Sum Additive Alternate Bid items. The Additive Alternates are specific parts of the overall project that were bid individually in an effort to ensure there would be enough funding in the construction budget to award the Base Bid and as many Additive Alternates as the construction budget would allow.

Five responsive bids were received. The responsive apparent low Base Bid and low Grand Total Bid (Base Bid plus all Additive Alternates) was received from Sunland Development Company, based in Homer Alaska. The construction budget is sufficient to award the Base Bid item and all six Additive Alternates, or Grand Total Bid.


