12	1. CLASSIFICATION. This ordinance is of a permanent nature and is intended to become a part of the Sittle General Code ("SGC")

15	2. SEVERABILITY. If any provision of this ordinance or any application to any
16	person or circumstance is held invalid, the remainder of this ordinance and application to any
17	person or circumstance shall not be affected.

19	3. PURPOSE. Sitka General Code Section 4.09.010, entitled "Levy of Sales Tax,"
20	subsection C is amended to reallocate the percentages of the revenues from the "Fish Box Sales
21 22	Tax" so that a greater percentage goes into the Harbor fund.
23	4. ENACTMENT. NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED by the
24	Assembly of the City and Borough of Sitka that SGC Chapter 4.09.010 "Levy of Sales
25	Tax" is amended as follows (new language underlined; deleted language stricken):

27	4.09.010 Levy of Sales Tax.

30 31	C. A flat rate of ten dollars per fish box shall be levied on the packaged fish and/or seafood
32	caught or taken and retained by fish charter customers as part of the fish charter. This tax shall be
33	paid by the fish charter customer, collected by whoever packages the fish and/or seafood caught
34	or taken by the fish charter customer, and is in addition to any sales tax paid based on the cost of
35	the charter. This tax is effective January 1, 2007. For purposes of this subsection, a "fish box"
36	means any packaging by a fish charter operator or processor of fish and/or seafood caught or
37 38	taken as part of the charter by a fish charter customer. The sales tax collected from this levy on fish boxes shall be deposited by the finance director in the following funds in the following
39	ratios:
40	1 Sixty Thirty percent in the harbor fund; and
41	2. Twenty Thirty percent in a fisheries enhancement fund, available to be used for any fisheries
42	enhancement proposal upon approval of the proposal by the assembly; and
43	3. Twenty Forty percent in the general fund.

44	 D. Except as provided in subsection C of this section, all moneys accumulated under the terms of
45	this chapter shall be deposited by the finance director in the general fund of the City and Borough
46	of Sitka and shall be used for the general operating expenses of the City and Borough of Sitka in
47	such a proportion as deemed advisable from time to time by the assembly.
