## **RESOLUTION NO. 2020-04**

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY AND BOROUGH OF SITKA AUTHORIZING THE MUNICIPAL ADMINISTRATOR TO APPLY FOR A LOAN WITH THE U.S. DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURE RURAL DEVELOPMENT FOR \$3,000,000 TO FUND THE SITKA GREEN LAKE HYDROELECTRIC REHABILITATION PHASE 1 PROJECT ("THE PROJECT") FOR THE COMPLETION OF THE DESIGN AND CONSTRUCTION OF THE PROJECT IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE FY2021 BUDGET

- WHEREAS, the existing Sitka Green Lake hydroelectric plant is a critical facility and part of the City's core infrastructure built in 1982, where approximately half of the electricity for the entire City of Sitka is generated; and
- WHEREAS, the facility's mechanical, electrical, and control systems, along with the water supply penstock, are due for major maintenance upgrades; and
- WHEREAS, the estimated Project cost of approximately \$5,000,000 exceeds current available funding from Electric Fund Working Capital; and
- WHEREAS, there is an urgency for completion of the rehabilitation of the Phase 1 project to ensure continued reliability of the electric system and to do investigative work for future Phase 2 and Phase 3.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Assembly of the City and Borough of Sitka to authorize the CBS Municipal Administrator to apply for a loan with the U.S. Department of Agriculture Rural Development for the funding shortfall of \$3,000,000 for the design and construction of the Sitka Green Lake Hydroelectric Rehabilitation Project in accordance with the FY2021 budget.
