Dear Assembly Members. I am writing to encourage you to support the upcoming proposal (September 14th agenda) to name the Kimsham soccer field after Sean Krueger who died this summer in the Coast Guard helicopter crash.

Sean joined the soccer program upon his transfer to Sitka in 2009. He coached the 6-7 year old outdoor and indoor seasons, was a team coach for the indoor soccer tournament last January, and was an official for the high school games that occurred in Sitka last season. My daughter had the good fortune to have him as coach during the indoor soccer tournament. Sean was a devoted and inspirational coach, treating all of his team members with respect. He had a quiet and encouraging manner, instilling in his players a love for the game.

Sean was an incredible role model not only for the soccer program but for community service as well. Despite having a demanding job and 3 young children, Sean also officiated for many of the home high school football games. Sean helped out at a fundraiser for the Baranof Elementary School's Parent Advisory Committee which his wife, Kyla, helped organize. The night of the event, Sean was there moving tables, watching children, handing out programs and bidding on items. He helped out until the bitter end, not leaving until the school was clean, the auction items were sorted, and the money was counted. He was instrumental in organizing the Kindergarten field trip to the USCG Air Station last May and led a kid-friendly, interesting and fun tour.

In the first few days after the crash, as I processed and discussed the tragedy with other Sitkans, I was struck by the number of people who were personally saddened by Sean's death. He touched a huge number of lives in the short time that he lived here. I would love to see his spirit of volunteerism, love of soccer, dedication to youth, and bravery in choice of career commemorated. I urge you to support naming the Kimsham soccer field after Sean Krueger.
