That the CBS does hereby authorize the Municipal Administrator to submit and sign 36 an application to the ADOT&PF for Community Transportation Program funds on behalf of the 37 citizens of the CBS. 38 39 Section 2. That the CBS hereby assures the ADOT&PF that sufficient funding for the CBS's 40 matching contribution for the Lincoln Street & Katlian Avenue Paving & Improvements Project is 41 available. 42 43 Section 3. That the CBS hereby assures the ADOT&PF that the CBS will commit to ownership, 44 maintenance and operations responsibilities and that sufficient funding for the Lincoln Street & 45 Katlian Avenue Paving & Improvements Project will be available for the life of the project. 46 47 Section 4. That the CBS supports the project entitled Lincoln Street & Katlian Avenue Paving & 48 Improvement Projects and agrees, subject to available STIP funding and programming by 49 ADOT&PF, to enter into a memorandum of agreement with the State of Alaska DOT&PF, in
