RESOLUTION NO. 2011-09

A RESOLUTION OF THE ASSEMBLY OF THE CITY AND BOROUGH OF SITKA, ALASKA COMMITTING TO A LEVEL OF FINANCIAL SUPPORT TO BE PROVIDED TO THE SITKA SCHOOL DISTRICT FOR FISCAL YEAR 2012

WHEREAS, Alaska Statute 14.14.060 provides that, "The Borough School Board shall submit the school budget for the following school year to the Borough Assembly by May 1 for approval of the total amount. Within 30 days after receipt of the budget the Assembly shall determine the total amount of money to be made available from local sources for school purposes and shall furnish the School Board with a statement of the sum to be made available. If the Assembly does not, within 30 days, furnish the School Board with a statement of the sum to be made available, the amount requested in the budget is automatically approved", and


WHEREAS, the City and Borough of Sitka School Board formally submitted a budget request to the Assembly of the City and Borough of Sitka on March 21, 2011, in the amount of \$6,346,062. This amount was comprised of \$5,026,975 for operational support, \$433,759 for various school-related expenditures which do not count against the funding cap, and funding from Secure Rural School (National Forest Receipts) in the amount of \$885,328.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Assembly of the City and Borough of Sitka, Alaska by this resolution hereby determines that money in the amount of \$6,346,062 will be made available in fiscal year 2012 from local and federal sources to the Sitka School District for school purposes.
