**Subject:** FY11 Alaska Drinking Water Fund and Alaska Clean Water Fund  
Loans with Principal Forgiveness

---

Background:

Each year staff submits loan applications to the Alaska Drinking Water Fund (ADWF) and Alaska Clean Water Fund (ACWF). Most recently, the loans have had a 20 year term at 1.5% interest. For the State Fiscal Year 2011, American Recovery and Reinvestment Act (Stimulus) funds have been added to the ADWF and ACWF

The following three projects were identified as being eligible for funding on June 9, 2010:

UV Disinfection Facility- Phase 1	ADWF	\$4,000,000
Japonski Island Sewer Lift Station Upgrades	ACWF	\$1,282,000
Monastery Street Sewer Rehabilitation	ACWF	\$932,000

Of the three projects listed above two of them have been provided the following subsidized amounts.

UV Disinfection Facility	ADWF	\$1,500,000
Japonski Island Sewer Lift Station Upgrades	ACWF	\$192,300

The UV Disinfection Facility is the next major water project mandated by EPA regulations. The Japonski sewer lift stations are obsolete and require pump replacement with state of the art submergible pumps. Monastery Street requires replacement of older concrete pipe sewer with ductile iron or PVC pipe. The project will also address the required separation between water and sewer pipes.

### Analysis

The total value of the funding for these projects through the ADWF and ACWF FY11 programs would be \$6,214,000. The subsidized amounts included in this year's program would result in a \$1,692,300 savings to the Water and Wastewater Funds.

### Recommendation:

**Approve Resolutions 2010-23 and 2010-24, authorizing the City and Borough to obtain ADWF and ACWF loans for the three projects listed above, in the amount of \$6,214,000, of which \$1,692,300 will be subsidized.**

A RESOLUTION OF THE ASSEMBLY OF THE CITY AND BOROUGH OF SITKA, ALASKA AUTHORIZING THE APPLICATION FOR A LOAN FROM THE ALASKA DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENTAL CONSERVATION UNDER THE ALASKA CLEAN WATER FUND FOR 1) MONASTERY STREET REHABILITATION AND 2) JAPONSKI SEWER LIFT STATIONS REHABILITATION

**WHEREAS,** the City and Borough of Sitka (CBS) seeks to obtain the necessary financial assistance to construct water and wastewater improvements; and

**WHEREAS,** the State of Alaska, Department of Environmental Conservation (the Department) is able to offer funding through the Alaska Clean Water Fund; and

**WHEREAS,** the Municipality wishes to apply for a loan from the Alaska Clean Water Fund for the 1) Monastery Street Rehabilitation and the 2) Japonski Sewer Lift Stations Rehabilitation

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Assembly of the City and Borough of Sitka, Alaska that the municipality is authorized to apply to the Alaska Department of Environmental Conservation for a loan from the Alaska Clean Water Fund for construction of wastewater projects named above. Jim Dinley, Administrator, is authorized to execute any and all documents that may be required by the Department to reflect the indebtedness, the terms of its repayment, and any security therefore, including but not limited to a loan agreement and promissory note.
