# **Background**

The Public Works Department held an auction (competitive bid) for surplus items no longer in service ending in April 2025. Two of the items require assembly approval in accordance with section 18.10.020 of the Sitka General Code prior to sale.

#247 1992 CAT 140 Grader (Streets) \$36K bid

#375 2006 MorBark 1000 Tub Grinder (Solid Waste) \$51K bid

#### **Analysis**

Equipment #247 is a 33 year-old grader that was replaced in 2022 by equipment #516, which is a 2022 CAT 150 Grader. Additionally, the Streets Division has a 2011 CAT 140 Grader. The Streets Division does not need a third grader and this one is taking up limited space at the Public Service Center Complex.

Equipment #375 is a 19 year-old tub grinder purchased by the Solid Waste Division for use at the Kimsham Landfill. Following closure of the landfill, attempts were made to repurpose the grinder for tires and glass but these efforts yielded poor results and additional maintenance. The tub grinder has not been used in several years and will continue to decline in material condition. The MorBark multi-bagger was optional equipment purchased at the same time and is to be included with the sale of the tub grinder.

Equipment #247 Original (1992) Purchase Price ~\$130K (30 Years in service) Equipment #375 Original (2006) Purchase Price ~\$190K (15 Years in service) (Morbark Multi Bagger Original Purchase Price ~\$47K)

# **Recommendation**

Upon discussion with all divisions, no feasible use for this equipment was identified. I recommend sale of the equipment so it may be restored and reused elsewhere. This supports initiatives of the administrator to remove excess/unused property and in a higher tier of the waste management hierarchy than scrapping/recycling.
