Subject: FY24 Historic Preservation Grants for Certified Local Governments: Sitka

Woman's Club's

Background

The Sitka Woman's Club (SWC) has requested that the City & Borough of Sitka (CBS) apply for a pass-through grant under the Historic Preservation Fund Grant for Certified Local Governments to support the continued restoration of the historic Sitka Woman's Clubhouse, also known as Cottage by the Sea. This building was added to the National Register of Historic Places in 2024. The Historic Preservation Commission unanimously recommended approval at their regular meeting on January 8, 2025.

Under this grant, SWC seeks to replace foundational support post and floor beams that have been compromised by rot, the crawlspace will be insulated and the cloth-covered wiring that is prevalent throughout the cottage and interspersed with modern plastic-coated wiring will be inspected and remediated.

The State of Alaska Office of History and Archeology announced the FY24 grant opportunity on November 6, 2024. The application deadline is February 7, 2025.

<u>Analysis</u>

The subgrantee must follow all applicable federal, state and city requirements regarding procurement, entity status, and reporting. Qualified historic preservation professionals must be consulted throughout the project as directed by the State Historic Preservation Office. If awarded, a municipal subgrantee agreement must be signed prior to commencement of the project. An administrative fee will be charged to the grant in accordance with Finance Department policy.

Fiscal Note

The grant application is for a 60-40 match grant. The Sitka Woman's Club's intends to contribute \$12,990 with in-kind and donated resources and requests \$16,000 from the Historic Preservation Fund for Certified Local Governments (Federal Share). CBS retains approximately 8.5% to cover administrative costs associated with grant management and reporting requirements.
