ORDINANCE NO. 2010-17

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY AND BOROUGH OF SITKA, ALASKA AMENDING SITKA GENERAL CODE SECTION 2.58.030 ENTITLED MEETINGS, ORGANIZATION AND OFFICERS TO INCLUDE PAID AGENTS DEPENDING ON AVAILABLE FUNDING.

1. CLASSIFICATION. This ordinance is of a permanent nature and is intended to become a part of the Sitka General Code.

2. SEVERABILITY. If any provision of this ordinance or any application to any person or circumstance is held invalid, the remainder of this ordinance and application to any person or circumstances shall not be affected.

3. PURPOSE. The Sitka Historic Preservation Commission has been established as a "Certified Local Government", which duties and responsibilities include assisting in the implementation of policy set by the Alaska Historic Preservation Act. These duties and responsibilities have become very time consuming for the Sitka Historic Preservation Commission member serving as an "agent." Therefore the purpose of the ordinance is to provide a means of compensation or pay on a contractual basis for the additional duties and responsibilities that the commission agent member(s) performs and assumes over and above their routine and voluntary commission duties, or to hire an agent, depending on funding.

4. ENACTMENT. NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED by the Assembly of the City and Borough of Sitka that: Chapter 2.58 of the Sitka General Code be amended at section 2.58.030 C. which shall read:

2.58.030 Meetings, organization and officers.

* * *

C. The officers of the commission shall be a chairman, vice chairman, and secretary, each of whom shall be elected by the members of the commission at the first meeting each fiscal year and shall serve a term to expire upon election of officers at the first meeting of the following fiscal year. Should an officer resign his office prior to the expiration of his term, or be otherwise unable or unwilling to perform his duties as required of the office, the commission may elect an officer to serve out the remainder of his term of office. In addition to the above officers, the commission, by a majority vote of its members, may designate and elect or appoint such other officers, assistant officers and agents, including paid agents depending on funding as it deems necessary at such time, in such manner and upon and for such terms as it shall prescribe. All officers and agents shall serve at the pleasure of the commission and may be removed, by a

47 majority vote of the commission, whenever in its judgment the best interests of the
48 commission will be served.
