## ORDINANCE NO. 2012-14

## AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY AND BOROUGH OF SITKA ADJUSTING THE FY 2012 BUDGET FOR KNOWN CHANGES

BE IT ENACTED by the Assembly of the City and Borough of Sitka, Alaska as follows:

- 1. **CLASSIFICATION.** This ordinance is not of a permanent nature and is not intended to be a part of the Sitka General Code of the City and Borough of Sitka, Alaska.
- 2. **SEVERABILITY.** If any provision of this ordinance or any application to any person or circumstance is held invalid, the remainder of this ordinance and application to any person and circumstances shall not be affected.
  - 3. PURPOSE. The purpose of this ordinance is to adjust the FY 2012 budget for known changes.
- 4. **ENACTMENT.** The Assembly of the City and Borough of Sitka hereby adjusts the FY 2012 Budget for known changes during the Second Quarter. In accordance with Section 11.10(a) of the Charter of the City and Borough of Sitka, Alaska, the budget for the fiscal period beginning July 1, 2011 and ending June 30, 2012 is hereby adjusted as follows:
