**RESOLUTION NO. 2022-09**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY AND BOROUGH OF SITKA (CBS) AUTHORIZING  
THE MUNICIPAL ADMINISTRATOR TO APPLY FOR AND EXECUTE A GRANT WITH  
THE ALASKA SUSTAINABLE SALMON FUND (AKSSF) FOR \$125,000  
TO SUPPORT THE WACHUSETTS STORM SEWER REHABILITATION PROJECT**

**WHEREAS**, the CBS-owned culvert conveying Peterson Creek under Wachusetts Street is badly corroded; and

**WHEREAS**, the culvert blocks or impedes fish access to over half of the stream length of fish spawning and rearing habitat; and

**WHEREAS**, the AKSSF is soliciting applications for projects to protect, restore and conserve fish habitats in Southeast Alaska; and

**WHEREAS**, the proposed culvert is being designed to improve the fish-passage characteristics of the existing, failing Wachusetts Street culvert.


**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Assembly of the City and Borough of Sitka to authorize the CBS Municipal Administrator to apply for and execute a grant with the AKSSF for \$125,000 to support the Wachusetts Storm Sewer Rehabilitation Project with a required 30% match funded by the project's existing General Funds.
