We are writing to offer the donation of a new AirFloor to enhance the gymnastics programming offered by the City and Borough of Sitka. This donation is made possible through the generous support of grant funding from the White Elephant, funding from the Sitka Sound Slayers, and individual contributions from dedicated Sitka Recreation Foundation donors.

With strong recommendations from your gymnastics instructor Trisha Bessert, to enhance safety and an expanded tumbling experience, an AirFloor measuring 40 feet by 25 feet by 4 inches has been purchased. This addition will allow your instructors to broaden the scope of your gymnastics programs, offering a safe and enjoyable experience for participants from tots to teens.

The AirFloor will be stored at the KGH facility, ensuring convenient access for your programming needs. We believe this donation will significantly benefit the community by:

- Increasing Participation: Attracting a wider range of participants due to the improved facilities.
