CERTIFICATE OF ELECTION

THIS IS TO CERTIFY THAT the results of the Regular Election held on October 5, 2010, including the Mayoral race has been certified by the Municipal Clerk and accepted by the Assembly on October 12 and 26, at two separate regular meetings.

The number of ballots issued was 3140 and the number of ballots counted was 3051. 2491 ballots were cast and counted Election Day an additional 560 question, absentee and special needs ballots were counted on October 11, 2010. A total of 89 ballots were spoiled, ineligible or not returned, broken down as follows: 50 spoiled, 22 ineligible, and 17 not returned. The results are tabulated below:


