ORDINANCE NO. 2013-06

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY AND BOROUGH OF SITKA AMENDING SECTION 15.01.020 OF THE SITKA GENERAL CODE ENTITLED "ELECTRICAL RATES" BY INCREASING RATES FOR ALL CUSTOMERS TO FUND APPROVED ELECTRICAL UTILITY CAPITAL PROJECTS INCLUDING THE BLUE LAKE HYDROELECTRIC EXPANSION PROJECT

1. CLASSIFICATION. This ordinance is of a permanent nature and is intended to become a part of the Sitka General Code ("SGC").

2. SEVERABILITY. If any provision of this ordinance or any application to any person or circumstance is held invalid, the remainder of this ordinance and application to any person or circumstance shall not be affected.

3. PURPOSE. This ordinance will increase the electrical rates at SGC 15.01.020 for all consumer groups to provide sufficient revenues to meet all fiscal requirements to complete approved capital projects, including the Blue Lake Hydroelectric Expansion Project. The ability to acquire reasonable cost financing for these projects requires electric rate increases to meet financial margins and revenue bond covenants.

4. ENACTMENT. NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED by the Assembly of the City and Borough of Sitka that SGC 15.01.020 is amended as follows (new language underlined; deleted language stricken):

E. Street and Security Light Service.

2. Rate per Month. This fee is in addition to the actual installation charges required for installing the desired fixture.

Monthly unmetered street or security light energy rate is calculated as follows:

(0.482 kWh per lamp watt) times (the wattage of the lamp) = kWh per month.	
Example: 0.482 kWh x 100 Watt lamp = 48 kWh per month.	
Monthly energy rate is: kWh per month times <u>\$0.1785</u> \$0.1552 per kWh.	
kWh per month x <u>\$0.1785</u> \$0.1552 /kWh= <u>\$8.57</u> \$7.45 per month energy rate.	
Typical lamp energy rates:	
70 Watt	<u>\$6.02</u> \$5.23 per month

100 Watt	\$8.57 \$7.45 per month
150 Watt	\$12.91 \$11.17 per month
175 Watt	\$15.06 \$13.04 per month
250 Watt	\$21.51 \$18.63 per month
400 Watt	\$34.41 \$29.95 per month
1,000 Watt	\$86.04 \$74.81 per month

3. Rate per Month. Basic customer charge for each month or portion of a month: one hundred dollars.

Energy Charge. The energy charge for all kilowatt-hours shall be 0.0317 times the city and borough’s price per gallon for number 2 heating oil, assuming an overall oil heating system efficiency of seventy percent and the use of the price paid by the city and borough of Sitka for number 2 heating oil for all of the city and borough-owned buildings. The rate will vary monthly with the price paid by the city and borough of Sitka for number 2 heating oil for all city-owned buildings. The maximum energy charge for all kilowatt hours under this rate shall be ~~ten~~ nine cents per kilowatt hour.

5. **EFFECTIVE DATE.** This ordinance shall become effective on July 1, 2013.
