

Subject: Approval of Acceptance for \$50K Drinking Water State Revolving Fund

(CFDA 66.468), EPA Lead Service Line Inventory Reimbursement through

the Alaska DEC Drinking Water Program

#### **Background**

In October 2024, The EPA published the Final Lead and Copper Rule Improvements. Under existing requirements, regulated water systems in Alaska must complete initial inventories of lead service lines and submit them to the Alaska Department of Environmental Conservation (ADEC). Funding was established to offset the costs of conducting these inventories through an EPA grant which is administered by ADEC.

### **Analysis**

Submission of an approved Lead Service Line Inventory is the only requirement to receive reimbursement. The City and Borough of Sitka inventoried 3180 service connections. The inventory has been submitted to the ADEC and has been accepted as complete, satisfying our water system's requirement for initial inventory. The number of service connections makes us eligible for a \$50,000 reimbursement.

### **Fiscal Note**

This is a one-time reimbursement for our work on the initial inventory. Reimbursement is accomplished by submitting an invoice to the ADEC Drinking Water Program. No additional appropriation needed.

#### Recommendation

Approve this Resolution authorizing the Municipal Administrator to apply for reimbursement under this grant.
