ORDINANCE NO. 2023-22 AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY AND BOROUGH OF SITKA MAKING SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATIONS FOR FISCAL YEAR 2024 (Residential Utility Account Credits)

BE IT ENACTED by the Assembly of the City and Borough of Sitka, Alaska as follows:

- 1. **CLASSIFICATION.** This ordinance is not of a permanent nature and is not intended to be a part of the Sitka General Code of the City and Borough of Sitka, Alaska.
- 2. **SEVERABILITY.** If any provision of this ordinance or any application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, the remainder of this ordinance and application thereof to any person and circumstances shall not be affected thereby.
- 3. **PURPOSE.** The purpose of this ordinance is to make a supplemental Operation appropriation for FY2024.
- 4. **ENACTMENT.** In accordance with Section 11.10 (a) of the Charter of the City and Borough of Sitka, Alaska, the Assembly hereby makes the following supplemental appropriation for the budget period beginning July 1, 2023 and ending June 30, 2024.

FISCAL YEAR 2024 EXPENDITURE BUDGETS

GENERAL FUND

Administration/Assembly – Operations: – Increase appropriations in the amount \$ 1,075,000 for residential utility account credits following the below qualifications.

Each residential utility account, meeting the following criteria, is eligible for a one-time subsidy in the amount of \$300.

Eligible accounts include:

- 1) Active accounts used as a primary residence (including harbor accounts designated as liveaboard accounts)
- 2) The account has to have been open for one year from the signing of this Ordinance.
- 3) One credit per account holder.
- 5. EFFECTIVE DATE. This ordinance shall become effective on the day after the date of its passage.
