9 10 11	BE IT ENACTED by the Assembly of the City and Borough of Sitka as follows:
12	1. CLASSIFICATION. This emergency ordinance is not of a permanent nature and is not
13 14	intended to be a part of the Sitka General Code of the City and Borough of Sitka.
14 15	2. SEVERABILITY. If any provision of this emergency ordinance and application thereof to
16 17	any person and circumstances is held invalid, the remainder of this emergency ordinance and application thereof to any person and circumstances shall not be affected thereby.
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19	3. PURPOSE. The purpose of this emergency ordinance is recited as follows:
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21	WHEREAS, Sitka is experiencing a substantial increase in COVID-19 cases which are primarily
22	attributed to the Delta variant and Sitka has been in the COVID-19 high alert status, with steady
23	positive tests and hospitalizations, and even a resident death, since July 5, 2021, and Sitka is currently experiencing one of its highest rates of persons testing positive for COVID-19; and
24 25	currently experiencing one of its highest fates of persons testing positive for COVID-19, and
25 26	WHEREAS, the Center for Disease Control and Prevention and the State of Alaska currently
20 27	require guarantine and isolation for 10 days for persons who test positive for COVID-19; and
28	require quarantine and isolation for to days for persons who test positive for COVID-19, and
29	WHEREAS, the quarantine and isolation for 10 days for persons who test positive for COVID-19
30	causes great financial hardships and inconvenience for those persons and their dependents;
31	and
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33	WHEREAS, federal financial support for persons required to quarantine and isolate expired on
34	December 31, 2020.
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36	4. ENACTMENT. NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED by the Assembly of the City and
37	Borough of Sitka that:
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39	Section 1. Grant Policy and Procedure. It shall be the policy of the City and Borough of Sitka
40	(CBS) that applicants meeting certain criteria, as listed below, shall be eligible for a \$1,000 grant
41	from the CBS General Fund. The grants shall be in the form of a check from the CBS.
42	Applications for grants shall be submitted to the Finance Department on forms provided by the
43	Finance Department. Applications must be submitted before the expiration of this emergency
44	ordinance. If the application is denied, the applicant may appeal to the Municipal Administrator.
45	The Municipal Administrator's decision is the final action of the CBS. The Finance Department
46	shall examine all applications, determine the eligibility of each applicant, accept or reject each
47	application, and disburse the grant to the accepted applicants. An applicant shall be eligible for
48 40	the \$1,000 grant if the applicant certified in his or her application, and provides documentation,
49 50	as follows: (1) The applicant is eighteen (18) years of age or elder; and
50 51	(1) The applicant is eighteen (18) years of age or older; and(2) The applicant is currently a resident of Sitka; and
51	(z) The applicant is currently a resident of Sitka, and

52 53	(3) The applicant tested positive for COVID-19 during the time period starting July 1, 2021, and ending at the expiration of this emergency ordinance, supported by documentation
54	of the positive test result; and
55 56	(4) The applicant quarantines and isolates for 10 days in accordance with CDC and State of Alaska guidelines; and
57	(5) The applicant was employed immediately prior to the positive test result, supported by a
58	pay stub or other satisfactory written evidence of employment; and
58 59	(6) The applicant provides an IRS Form W-9.
59 60	An applicant is eligible for a grant even if the applicant has overdue obligation owed to the
60 61	CBS. The application may be submitted to the CBS by email.
62	CDS. The application may be submitted to the CDS by email.
62 63	Section 2. Implementation. These grants shall be implemented with a supplemental
63 64	Section 2. Implementation. These grants shall be implemented with a supplemental appropriation from the CBS General Fund, not to exceed \$300,000.
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66	5. EMERGENCY DECLARATION: The Assembly hereby finds that the facts and
67	legislative findings set forth above in Section 3 constitute an emergency as required by the
68	Home Rule Charter of the City and Borough of Sitka, Section 3.03 "Emergency Ordinances."
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70	6. EFFECTIVE DATE. This emergency ordinance shall become effective on the day it is
71	adopted and expires once \$300,000 of grant funds are expended or 61 days after adoption,
72	whichever occurs first. In accordance with Charter Section 3.03, this emergency ordinance may
73	be re-enacted by the Assembly if the emergency still exists upon expiration.
