ORDINANCE NO. 2012-13

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY AND BOROUGH OF SITKA AMENDING SITKA GENERAL CODE SUBSECTION 13.06.010L ENTITLED "LAUNCH RAMP FEES" TO BE CONSISTENT WITH ALASKA STATE PARK BOAT LAUNCH FEES

1. CLASSIFICATION. This ordinance is of a permanent nature and is intended to become a part of the Sitka General Code ("SGC").

2. SEVERABILITY. If any provision of this ordinance or any application to any person or circumstance is held invalid, the remainder of this ordinance and application to any person or circumstance shall not be affected.

3. PURPOSE. This ordinance will amend SGC 13.06.010L regarding launch fees to be more in-line with State of Alaska Department of Natural Resources, Division of Parks and Outdoor Recreation boat launch fees.

The Port and Harbors Commission has recommended approval of this SGC change.

4. ENACTMENT. NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED by the Assembly of the City and Borough of Sitka that SGC 13.06.010 entitled "Moorage Charges and Fees," Subsection L is amended as follows (new language underlined; deleted language stricken):

13.06.010 Moorage charges and fees.

\* \* \*

L. Launch Ramp Fees. The launch ramp fees for the use of a City and Borough of Sitka launch ramp is as follows:

- 1. Daily rate of ten dollars per day for each trailer.
2. Annual rate of seventy-five dollars per year for the first trailer for an annual permit.
3. Launch ramp fees are not applicable to current harbor users paying moorage.

- 1           4. For additional trailer(s) registered to same owner:
- 2           a. forty dollars for second trailer;
- 3           b. twenty-five dollars for second trailer if fee is paid at same time as for first
- 4           trailer; and
- 5           c. seventy-five dollars each for third and subsequent trailer(s).

7           5. **EFFECTIVE DATE.** This ordinance shall become effective sixty days

8 from the date of passage.

## Alaska State Park Fees

Annual camping passes are no longer available. The program was discontinued in 2004.

### Annual passes:

- Daily Parking Pass: \$40
  - Second Daily Parking Pass\*: \$20
- \* Boat Launch Pass: \$75
  - Second Boat Launch Pass\*: \$40
- Discount when both passes bought together: \$100
  - (discount of \$15)
- Disabled Veteran's Annual Camping Pass - Free  
*Check eligibility requirements.*

\*Second pass discount for same family at same address only. Third and subsequent day use and boat launch passes are full price.

Passes are good for the calendar year end and are honored in most state parks.

Note: Some parks are managed by private firms and do not accept day use and boat launch passes. Contact your local park office for more information. [Also see the fee listing by facility for more information.](#)

### Individual Fees:

- Nightly camping: \$10 to \$28 per night
- Daily parking: \$5 to \$10 per vehicle
- Boat launches: \$5 to \$10 per day
- Sanitary dump station: \$5
- Firewood: \$8 maximum per bundle where available
- Guided tours of historic sites: \$2 to \$10
