RESOLUTION 2010-01**

**A RESOLUTION BY THE CITY AND BOROUGH OF SITKA SUPPORTING
ANB HALL UPGRADE ON ITS 100TH ANNIVERSARY AND
FUNDING FOR SITKA COMMUNITY HOSPITAL EQUIPMENT**

WHEREAS, the City and Borough of Sitka supports major institutional upgrades of Sitka facilities of great importance to the community; and

WHEREAS, the first Alaska Native Brotherhood (ANB) Hall was built in Sitka one-hundred years ago, and the Grand Camp Alaska Native Brotherhood and Alaska Native Sisterhood (ANS) originated in Sitka, Alaska, and has been a significant factor in Sitka's Native community history, social and ceremonial activities, and maintenance of the Native heritage from its inception to present but has lacked adequate funding to optimally care for its large, heavily used historic building; and


WHEREAS, Sitka Community Hospital is also an integral part of the Sitka community, providing critical care, health and wellness services, and long-term care for the entire community of Sitka, but lacking adequate funding to upgrade needed hospital equipment to adequately serve the community; and

WHEREAS, both these organizations serve major State and local interests, and their upgrades would benefit the entire community of Sitka;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Assembly of the City and Borough of Sitka, Alaska, supports the State of Alaska providing \$50,000 for the Centennial Anniversary Upgrade of ANB/ANS Hall, and further supports the State of Alaska providing \$374,493 to upgrade Sitka Community Hospital's equipment, per its capital request to the Alaska State Legislature.

NOW, FURTHER BE IT RESOLVED that the Assembly of the City and Borough of Sitka, Alaska, considers ANB Hall upgrade and Sitka Community Hospital equipment upgrade as high Sitka Legislative Priorities.

PASSED, APPROVED, AND ADOPTED by the Assembly of the City and Borough of Sitka, Alaska, on this 12th day of January, 2010.
