BACKGROUND

The purpose of this Alaska Tideland Survey (ATS) 1753 is to define a lease boundary area for State of Alaska tidelands adjacent to Tract F of U.S. Survey 3555. The leased boundary area encompasses improvements of a dock, float, and gangway. DNR requires Platting Authority approval for tideland surveys and is requesting any corrections to the survey at this time.

ANALYSIS

Project/Site: The defined lease boundary area consists of 0.23 acres and encompasses a dock, float, and gangway seaward of NHN Gilmore Island in the General Island (GI) district. Property currently has a single-family home.

Traffic: No traffic impacts.

Parking: No required parking for island districts.

Noise: No change in the level of noise is anticipated.

Public Health or Safety: No negative impacts to public health or safety is anticipated.

Public Value or Neighborhood Harmony: The use is not changing and there are no known impacts to neighboring properties.

Conformity with Comprehensive Plan: The proposal is consistent with the Comprehensive Plan by providing a pathway for property owners to lease State owned tidelands for island development.

RECOMMENDATION

Staff recommends approval of Alaska Tideland Survey 1753 to define a tideland lease boundary area. One motion approving the tidelands survey is required.
