AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY AND BOROUGH OF SITKA ADJUSTING THE FY 2011 BUDGET FOR CHANGES IDENTIFIED DURING THE THIRD QUARTER FY 2011 FORMAL BUDGET EXECUTION REVIEW

BE IT ENACTED by the Assembly of the City and Borough of Sitka, Alaska as follows:

- 1. **CLASSIFICATION.** This ordinance is not of a permanent nature and is not intended to be a part of the Sitka General Code of the City and Borough of Sitka, Alaska.
- 2. **SEVERABILITY.** If any provision of this ordinance or any application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, the remainder of this ordinance and application thereof to any person and circumstances shall not be affected thereby.
- 3. **PURPOSE.** The purpose of this ordinance is to adjust the FY 2011 budget for changes identified during the Third Quarter, FY 2011 Formal Budget Execution Review.
- 4. **ENACTMENT.** The Assembly of the City and Borough of Sitka hereby adjusts the FY 2011 Budget for changes identified during the Third Quarter, FY 2011 Formal Budget Execution Review. In accordance with Section 11.10(a) of the Charter of the City and Borough of Sitka, Alaska, the budget for the fiscal period beginning July 1, 2010 and ending June 30, 2011 is hereby adjusted as follows:
