1 CITY AND BOROUGH OF SITKA 2 3 **RESOLUTION NO. 2022-22** 4 5 A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY AND BOROUGH OF SITKA (CBS) AUTHORIZING 6 THE MUNICIPAL ADMINISTRATOR TO APPLY FOR A SAFE STREETS FOR ALL (SS4A) 7 GRANT WITH THE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION (DOT) FOR \$550,000 WITH A 8 \$150,000 MATCH COMMITMENT TO SUPPORT DEVELOPMENT OF A COMPREHENSIVE 9 SAFETY ACTION PLAN 10 11 WHEREAS, the 2030 Comprehensive Plan included, Adopt and Implement a Sitka Complete 12 Streets Policy and Maintain and Improve Sitka's Land Based Transit Infrastructure. 13 such as Streets and Sidewalks which includes pursue grants to make 14 transportation infrastructure safer, and 15 16 WHEREAS, a dedicated infrastructure fund has been established but it does not have a 17 dedicated revenue stream and the majority of the funding for roads is allocated 18 from the General Fund; and 19 20 WHEREAS, according to the 2014 Road System Master Planning and Funding Strategies most 21 of the current road base material is not free draining and is not "non frost 22 susceptible" material so many of the roads exhibit cracking and potholes; and 23 24 WHEREAS, the 2014 Road Master Planning and Funding Strategies states several CBS roads 25 are beyond their service life including sections of Lincoln Street; and 26 27 WHEREAS, CBS has had six serious injuries between 2016 and 2020 which allows for a goal to achieve zero roadway fatalities and serious injuries; and 28 29 30 WHEREAS, CBS proposes a \$700,000 project to develop an Action Plan; and 31 32 WHEREAS, DOT announced a SS4A Grant opportunity to develop a Comprehensive Safety 33 Action Plan prior to applying for an implementation grant and CBS is eligible for a maximum expected up to \$1 million in funds. 34 35 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Assembly of the City and Borough of Sitka to 36 37 authorize the CBS Municipal Administrator to apply for a Safe Streets and Roads for All (SS4A) 38 Grant with the Department of Transportation for \$550,000 with a CBS match commitment of 39 \$150,000 for a total project cost of \$700,000. 40 41 PASSED, APPROVED, AND ADOPTED by the Assembly of the City and Borough of Sitka, 42 Alaska on this 23rd day of August 2022. 43 44 45 Steven Eisenbeisz, Mayor 46 47 ATTEST: 48 49 50 Sara Peterson, MMC 51 Municipal Clerk 52 53 1st and final reading: 8/23/2022 54 55 Sponsor: Administrator
