4	AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY AND BOROUGH OF SITKA, ALASKA
5	MODIFYING CHAPTER 4.24 OF THE SITKA GENERAL CODE, HOTEL, MOTEL
6	AND BED AND BREAKFAST TRANSIENT ROOM TAX, BY ADDING SECTION
7	4.24.070 WHICH CREATES A SPECIAL REVENUE FUND ENTITLED "VISITOR
8	ACTIVITIES ENHANCEMENT FUND," WHICH DIRECTS THAT ALL BED TAXES
9	COLLECTED ARE DEPOSITED IN THE FUND, AND WHICH SETS FORTH POLICY
10	AS TO HOW SUCH FUNDS MAY BE APPROPRIATED AND USED
11	
12	<b>BE IT ENACTED</b> by the Assembly of the City and Borough of Sitka, Alaska as follows:
13	
14	1. CLASSIFICATION. This ordinance is of a permanent nature and is intended to
15	become a part of the Sitka General Code.
16	
17	2. SEVERABILITY. If any provision of this ordinance or any application thereof to
18	any person or circumstance is held invalid, the remainder of this ordinance and application
19	thereof to any person or circumstances shall not be affected thereby.
20	
21	3. <b>PURPOSE.</b> The purposes of this ordinance is to create a new special revenue fund of
22	the City and Borough of Sitka into which all Hotel, Motel, and Bed and Breakfast Transient
23	Room Taxes collected shall be deposited, and, to set forth policy as to how such proceeds in the
24	fund may be appropriated.
25	
26	4. <b>ENACTMENT.</b> The Assembly of the City and Borough of Sitka hereby amends
27	Chapter 4.24 of the Sitka General Code by adding Section 4.24.070 entitled "Visitor Activities
28	Enhancement Fund," as follows:

31 32	4.24.070 VISITOR ACTIVITIES ENHANCEMENT FUND
32 33	VISITOR ACTIVITIES ENHANCEMENT FUND
34	A. A new special revenue fund of the city and borough of Sitka, entitled the Visitor
35	Activities Enhancement Fund, is henceforth created. The purpose of the Visitor Activities
36	Enhancement Fund shall be to serve as a depository for all hotel, motel, and bed and
37	breakfast transient room taxes henceforth collected until such funds are appropriated for
38 39	visitor enhancement purposes.

40 41 42	B. All hotel, motel, and bed and breakfast transient room taxes collected will be deposited into the Visitor Activities Enhancement Fund.
43	C. The Administrator, through the preparation of the Annual Consolidated Operating Budget
44	of the Municipality, shall plan for the appropriation of funds contained in the Visitor
45	Activities Enhancement Fund. If appropriations are required above the amount authorized in
46	the Annual Consolidated Operating Budget of the Municipality, the Administrator shall bring
47	forth supplemental appropriation ordinances, in accordance with the Home Rule Charter of
48	the City and Borough of Sitka.
49	
50	D. The proceeds contained in the Visitor Activities Enhancement Fund may be appropriated
51 52	by the Assembly for any purpose related to the enhancement of tourism and visitor-related
52 53	activities in the Municipality, to include but not be limited to contractual funding of a Convention and Visitor's Bureau, funding of travel of Municipal officials to travel-related
55 54	conventions and trade shows, and procurement of tourism-related advertising. All such
55	procurements shall be subject to Municipal procurement regulations in accordance with Title
56	III of the Sitka General Code.
57	
58	E. If at any such time the Visitor Activities Enhancement Fund is dissolved, the net
59	proceeds of the Fund will revert back to the General Fund. Also, at any time through an
60	appropriation, the Assembly may direct the transfer of any amount of unexpended proceeds
61	in the Visitor Activities Enhancement Fund to any other fund of the Municipality to be used
62	for any lawful purpose.
63 64	F. Any investment earnings on the unspent proceeds contained in the Visitor Activities
65	Enhancement Fund shall be added to the corpus of the Fund and will be available for
66	appropriation by the Assembly.
67	
68	5. <b>EFFECTIVE DATE.</b> This ordinance shall become effective July 1, 2015.
