M. Energy Assistance Fund. An energy assistance fund is hereby established to provide an opportunity for City and Borough of Sitka electric customers to make a voluntary monthly contribution to a fund that will provide limited financial assistance to customers. The intent of the program is to help provide emergency financial assistance to customers to pay electric utility bills. The program will be administered by the Salvation Army.

<u>N.</u>

Plug-in Electric Vehicle (PEV) Incentive Credit. A \$120.00 annual PEV energy credit will be applied to all eligible Residential Class customers that register and operate an plug-in electric vehicle within the CBS up to a maximum of 2 PEV's per household. A \$200.00 annual PEV energy credit will be applied to all eligible General Service customers that register and operate an plug-in electric vehicle within the CBS up to a maximum of 5 PEV's.

5. **EFFECTIVE DATE**. This ordinance shall become effective on the day after the date of its passage.
