### **ORDINANCE NO. 2015-53**

## AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY AND BOROUGH OF SITKA **ADJUSTING THE FY16 BUDGET**

BE IT ENACTED by the Assembly of the City and Borough of Sitka, Alaska as follows:

- 1. CLASSIFICATION. This ordinance is not of a permanent nature and is not intended to be a part of the Sitka General Code of the City and Borough of Sitka, Alaska.
