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15	1. <b>CLASSIFICATION.</b> This ordinance is of a permanent nature and is intended to
16	become a part of the Sitka General Code ("SGC").
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18	2. <b>SEVERABILITY.</b> If any provision of this ordinance or any application to any
19	person or circumstance is held invalid, the remainder of this ordinance and application to any
20	person or circumstance shall not be affected.
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22	3. <b><u>PURPOSE</u></b> . The purpose of this ordinance is to amend SGC Title 7 by adding
23	Chapter 7.20 "Marijuana Advisory Committee" to recommend the Marijuana Advisory
24	Committee become the interim Local Regulatory Authority, for purposes as set forth in
25	Alaska Statute 17.38, with staff support from the Office of Planning and Community
26	Development starting immediately and ending February 24, 2016 or until a permanent
27	body is designated.
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29	4. <b>ENACTMENT.</b> NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED by the Assembly of
30	the City and Borough of Sitka that SGC Chapter 7.20 is created as set out below (new language
31	underlined; deleted language stricken):

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37	7.20.010 Marijuana Advisory Committee
38	A. There is created the Marijuana Advisory Committee, referred to in this chapter as the
39	Committee. The Committee shall serve as the Local Regulatory Authority for purposes of
40	AS 17.38.
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42	B. The Committee consists of nine voting members, the composition is as follows:
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44	1. Six members; three from the public at large and one each from the Police and Fire
45	Commission, Health Needs and Human Services Commission, and the School Board.
46	If no volunteers from each of these boards and commissions can be found, the
47	Assembly may select members from the public to fill each vacant seat.

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- 3. The City Attorney will sit on the Committee in an advisory capacity, with no voting rights.
- 4. The Committee will receive staff support processing applications, setting up rules and regulations for time, place and manner restriction from the office of Planning and Community Development.

## 58 7.20.030 Proceedings of the Committee

The Committee shall meet regularly as needed and at the call of the Chair. Permanent records or minutes shall be kept of the vote of each member upon every question. Every decision of finding shall immediately be filed in the office of the City Clerk, and shall be public record open to inspection by any person. Every decision of finding shall be directed to the Assembly at the earliest possible date.

## **7.20.040 Sunset Clause**

If no permanent body is designated by February 24, 2016, the Committee shall continue as the
Local Regulatory Authority until a permanent body is appointed by the Assembly.

## 69 7.20.050 Duties and responsibilities of the Committee

It shall be the duty of the Committee to act in an advisory capacity to the Administrator and
Assembly on the regulation of marijuana and operation of marijuana facilities within the City
and Borough of Sitka. Further duties shall include but not be limited to:

- A. Work with the State to collect fees and administer licensing and regulations. Draft recommended laws and policies for Assembly approval, regulating marijuana and related facilities within the City and Borough of Sitka.
  - B. Make recommendations, for Assembly approval, on time, place and manner regulations related to use, manufacturing and distribution of marijuana.
  - C. Supervise and monitor the implementation and enforcement of laws and policies governing marijuana, in conjunction with the City Attorney, Department of Planning and Community Development, the City Administrator, and the State authorities.
  - D. Analyze the economic impact of marijuana regulation in the City and Borough of Sitka, and working with the city Finance Department, make recommendations on taxation of marijuana.
  - E. Analyze the environmental impact of manufacturing of marijuana, working with both the Electric department and wastewater treatment department.

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93	5. <b>EFFECTIVE DATE.</b> This ordinance shall become effective on the day after the
94	date of its passage.
