

CITY AND BOROUGH OF SITKA

ORDINANCE NO. 2017-36
AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY AND BOROUGH OF SITKA
ADJUSTING THE FY18 BUDGET

BE IT ENACTED by the Assembly of the City and Borough of Sitka, Alaska as follows:

1. **CLASSIFICATION.** This ordinance is not of a permanent nature and is not intended to be a part of the Sitka General Code of the City and Borough of Sitka, Alaska.

2. **SEVERABILITY.** If any provision of this ordinance or any application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, the remainder of this ordinance and application thereof to any person and circumstances shall not be affected thereby.

3. **PURPOSE.** The purpose of this ordinance is to adjust the FY18 budgets for known changes.

4. **ENACTMENT.** The Assembly of the City and Borough of Sitka hereby adjusts the FY18 budget for known changes. In accordance with Section 11.10(a) of the Charter of the City and Borough of Sitka, Alaska, the budget for the fiscal period beginning July 1, 2017 and ending June 30, 2018 is hereby adjusted as follows:

<u>FISCAL YEAR 2018 EXPENDITURE BUDGETS</u>
In accordance with Section 11.10 (a) of the Charter of the City and Borough of Sitka, Alaska, the operating budget for the fiscal period beginning July 1, 2017 and ending June 30, 2018 is hereby adjusted.
Special Revenue Funds
Fund 194 – Commercial Passenger Vessel Excise Tax – Operations: The amount of \$50,000 is hereby re-appropriated to partially fund the completion of the Sitka History Museum’s interior. This expenditure is deemed to enhance the efficiency of interstate and foreign commerce, in accordance with Federal law.

EXPLANATION

Necessary revisions in the FY 2018 budget were identified. These changes involve the increase of expenditure accounts and causes decreased cash flows to the fund balance of various funds. A short explanation of each budget revision is included.

5. **EFFECTIVE DATE.** This ordinance shall become effective on the day after the date of its passage.
