Dan,

Thanks for the reply. Our intent with the letter was to let CBS know our intentions with this project. We did not intend to do an expensive IHA. We came to and verified this plan with 4 different people at USACE and NMFS.

With that comes the reality that one person with an agenda during the permitting process could make it not feasible. Although the initial and subsequent contacts with the two main agencies were positive to this avenue of permitting, we don't have full control over their decisions.

That was the real reason for our letter, that if we could not do as planned, which was to get an informal permit and were forced into obtaining an IHA it would need to be a change of conditions.

We are fairly confident that due to pile size, number of pile, and sound mitigation we can get the permit.

Tamico will put the ball in CBS's court. It would be financially beneficial to CBS to pursue this contract in this manner. We do not wish to withdraw or bid, we only needed to clarify our approach to the very subjective process of permitting.
