28	City and Borough of Sitka at its regular municipal election on October 6, 2020, which is an		
29	ADVISORY VOTE in accordance with Sitka General Code 2.40.130. The advisory ballot		
30	proposition asks whether the Assembly should remove the Baranov statue from its current
