## **Section 2- Grant Request Information**

St Gregory's is the local non-profit Catholic Church in Sitka. We provide the space and equipment with volunteer workers to accommodate to any in need in our community a hot lunch meal every Saturday for the past 14 years, as well as a Sack lunch meal for each 5th Sunday in a given month for the past two years. We have additionally on occasion provided and delivered meals to folks at Ak State senior/disabled Housing, and to Sitka Safe Shelter.

We would propose to use the funds provided through this grant to replace aged commercial grade range/oven/griddle in our State of Alaska inspected and licensed kitchen, with like replacement. We would further seek to replace our commercial grade coffee maker with like replacement; thus enabling us to continue to serve our community.

We generally serve between 20-40 persons on any given Saturday, and we happily serve anyone who comes through our door. Most of the expense for the meals as well as equipment come from donations.

I have attached two months of documentation that reflects St. Gregory's income/ expense, as well as a spread sheet to reflect 12 month income/expense figures only. I do also have on file a spread sheet reflecting the last two years of cash donations to be used towards the Soup Kitchen. If you would like a copy of this I would be glad to provide it.
