A RESOLUTION BY THE CITY AND BOROUGH OF SITKA SUPPORTING SITKA MARITIME HERITAGE SOCIETY'S APPLICATION UNDER THE FY21 HISTORIC PRESERVATION FUND GRANT PROGRAM FOR CERTIFIED LOCAL GOVERNMENTS

- **WHEREAS**, the mission of the Sitka Maritime Heritage Society is to preserve our region's rich maritime history and promote knowledge of maritime heritage and skills; and
- WHEREAS, the historic Japonski Island Boathouse holds cultural significance for the community; and
- WHEREAS, the Sitka Maritime Heritage Society's goal through this grant application is to continue historic restoration of the Japonski Island Boathouse which is a distinctive waterfront structure built as a part of Sitka's Naval Air Station in 1941; and
- WHEREAS, the Sitka Maritime Heritage Society proposes to contribute \$15,224 of in-kind, donated, and purchased resources to the project while requesting \$22,835 from the Historic Preservation Fund for Certified Local Governments; and
- WHEREAS, the Sitka Maritime Heritage Society, if awarded the grant, will be obligated to follow all applicable federal, state, and city requirements regarding procurement, entity status, and reporting. If awarded, a municipal subgrantee agreement must be signed prior to commencement of the project and an administrative fee will be charged to the grant in accordance with Finance Department policy.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Assembly of the City and Borough of Sitka hereby supports the FY21 application of the Sitka Maritime Heritage Society for a \$38,059 grant through the Historic Preservation Fund Grant program for Certified Local Governments.
